"New Organometallics"

First presentation of Foundation-assisted research results in Japan (1993)
Organometallics, which have the properties of both organic substances and metals, serve valuable functions as catalysts and reagents. The presentation program on Foundation-assisted research in new organometallics included three presentations by researchers as well as a special lecture by Professor Richard Schrock of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Topics included present and future applications for organometallics. Following the lectures and a panel discussion, 13 researchers presented poster displays of their work.
