Through research into new glass formations, production techniques and melting methods, scientists are developing potential applications for glass as optoelectronics materials, materials used in solar cells and batteries, and materials used to make bone replacements. Used in people's everyday lives since ancient times, glass will continue to be an important material in the future. The presentation program on Foundation-assisted research in the glass sciences included a keynote address by Professor Sumio Sakka of the Fukui University of Technology, three presentations by other lecturers and 13 poster displays.
